### One Day Workshop

#### Having a problem painting those faces? Can't get that nose to look just right?

During this workshop, award winning artist Dale Cochran will share his approach to painting watercolor portraits. This class will concentrate on proportions, structure, light and shadow. There will be an instructor demonstration and one-on-one instruction as you work on your piece. During the brown bag lunch hour, Dale will be doing a painting demonstration.

**Students are asked to do a preliminary drawing on watercolor paper prior to the class to maximize the time for painting and individual instruction.**

**Please prepare a preliminary drawing prior to class.** This will maximize the time for individual instruction. You may have a portrait you are currently working on...bring it in. **Remember to bring your reference photos too.**

### YOU WILL NEED TO BRING YOUR OWN SUPPLIES

*You are not required to purchase any new supplies for this workshop. Bring what you are using. If you plan to purchase any supplies here are some suggestions.*

#### BRUSHES

Bring what you are using. If you don't have watercolor brushes I would suggest a #5 and/or #7 round Kolinsky Sable.

#### PAINT

Bring what you are using. Some of the colors I use are listed below.

*I use Winsor & Newton, M.Graham and Holbein watercolors*

- Cadmium Yellow
- Cerulean Blue
- Cadmium Red
- Indian Red
- Yellow Ochre
- Payne's Gray
- Alizarin Crimson
- Rose Dore
- Raw Umber
- Prussian Blue
- Brown Madder

#### PAPER

I will be using 300 lb. D'Arches Cold Press watercolor paper in my demonstration.

#### SOME ADDITIONAL TOOLS

- A sketch/note pad
- Pencil - HB or 2B
- Knead Eraser
- Sea Sponges
- Maskoid
- Razor Blade or something sharp to scrape with
- Old toothbrush
- A water bottle with a trigger spray
